Viewpoint 11 A96 W of Mosstodloch

Existing View

This view is located at a forestry entrance on the A96 and looks out to the south across the road. Views to the north are screened by adjacent woodland. Nearby to the southeast, caravans being stored can be seen at Cowfords Farm. The remainder of the view comprises the main road extending away to west and east and gently undulating fields beyond this to the south, broken up by woodlands and shelterbelts with hills beyond, some of which are forested. The communications masts at Knock More, to the left of Ben Aigan, and on the open hilltop of Brown Muir can clearly be seen

Predicted Change

The Proposed Development would be seen on the skyline to the south, with turbines standing above the forestry seen between the distant Ben Rinnes summit and Brown Muir. At night, all four aviation lights would be seen alongside the lights on the Knock More mast and beyond lights on passing traffic.

Cumulative

Some of the turbines at Aultmore would be visible looking along the road to the east, with some of the aviation lights potentially seen through roadside vegetation and with the closer group of turbines more openly visible in winter. Turbines at Kellas Drum would be mostly screened by intervening forestry.
