

Teindland Wind Farm

Viewpoint 12 Miltonduff

Existing View

This viewpoint is located at the edge of the village adjacent to the village hall and war memorial, which are seen nearby to the north, along with houses in the village. Views over the nearby pasture to the south look out over undulating landform to include the tops of trees along Black Burn, and successive layers of hills and forestry. The open hill of Brown Muir forms a relatively prominent focus on the skyline.

Predicted Change

The proposed turbines would mostly be seen as blade tips above Brown Muir, with up to two turbine hubs also seen. At night, the light on T1 would be seen just above the skyline, along with a small number of lights at Rothes III wind farm.

Cumulative

Turbines at Aultmore may be distantly visible through intervening trees to the east. Kellas Drum wind farm would be seen on the more nearby skyline to the south above the forestry, with the turbine towers mostly screened by terrain and forestry. Aviation lights would be visible on some of the Kellas Drum turbines.


