



Maisemore Farm Solar Farm Update

Spring 2026

We wanted to share a brief update on activity at the solar farm site over the winter period and let you know what to expect in the coming weeks.

Despite the challenging weather, some construction activity has been able to continue over the winter months. Our contractor, GreenFrog, has been progressing with the foundations for the transformer platform.

Upcoming Works

A small team will shortly return to site to carry out further groundworks. We are also expecting the delivery of the transformer modules and a lifting crane. Because these deliveries involve an unusually large load, we are currently assessing all possible delivery options. We will give updates on this as the traffic plan develops.

To support the movement of vehicles and to maintain safe access, we plan to complete tree and hedge trimming along Persh Lane by mid-March before any birds begin nesting behaviours.

Traffic Management

As construction activity increases this Spring, we're very grateful for your patience. Safety remains our highest priority.

We want to reassure residents that we are working hard to minimise disruption, including limiting vehicle movements to daytime hours, avoiding unnecessary noise, and ensuring the lane remains safe for users.

A small construction team is scheduled to return in mid-March. However, ongoing wet weather means we are monitoring conditions closely, and this may lead to some delay. We will keep the community informed if timings change.
